**A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF ERIE RECOMMENDING THAT THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES APPROVE AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.6.12.F.2 OF THE ERIE MUNICIPAL CODE, REGARDING FLASHING OR MOVING SIGNS**

**WHEREAS**, for all amendments to Title 10 of the Erie Municipal Code, a recommendation from the Planning Commission to the Board of Trustees is necessary.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The Planning Commission hereby recommends that the Board of Trustees adopt the ordinance amending Section 10.6.12.F.2 of the Erie Municipal Code, relating to flashing or moving signs as amended as follows:

**2. Flashing or Moving Signs.** No flashing signs, signs emitting sounds, rotating or moving signs, animated signs, signs with moving lights or signs that create the illusion of movement shall be permitted. A sign whereon the current time or temperature is shown by intermittent lighting shall not be deemed to be a flashing sign. *A sign that changes copy or color no more than once every four (4) hours shall not be considered a flashing or moving sign.*
