Description of request:*

Investing in our future means investing in our children — which is why the United Nations has designated every November 20th as Universal Children’s Day. It’s a time to promote togetherness around the world, awareness of the problems children face in every corner of the globe, and improve the welfare for all children. To celebrate Universal Children’s Day at school, teachers will be teaching students about the lives of kids their age in different parts of the world. In support of this day, NAACP Boulder County is requesting grant funding to provide every elementary and middle school classroom in Erie with a Crayola Colors of the World kit that includes 24 skin tone pencils, 24 skin tone crayons, 24 skin tone markers and a 48 page Colors of the World Coloring book. This will allow Erie students to represent themselves and other children from around the world in a way that reflects their racial and ethnic diversity. These supplies will be dropped off to each Erie elementary and middle school in early November to support Universal Children’s Day and can also be used throughout the entire school year.

How will this event positively effect the community members and the Town of Erie:*

All children should have the supplies they need to draw themselves and their families in ways that reflects their racial and ethnic diversity. Unfortunately, the standard coloring supplies that many schools purchase do not include the wide array of skin tone colors that make up our increasingly diverse community and communities throughout the world. This grant will provide Erie teachers with essential supplies not only for Universal Children’s Day, but for the remainder of the school year. NAACP has secured a 15% discount from Crayola for the purchase of these supplies.
