

Summary:

The Resolution, provided for consideration by the Board of Trustees, accepts dedications on the plat and authorizes the appropriate town official to sign the plat and Vista Ridge Filing No. 2, 1st Amendment Development Agreement which outlines obligations of the Town and the Owners for Vista Ridge Filing No. 2, 1st Amendment Final Plat.

Project Description:

The Vista Ridge Filing No. 2, 1st Amendment Final Plat creates 25 single family lots, 3 tracts and associated private drives on 4.036 acres.
