A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie Approving the Expenditure of an Additional \$80,000 to Complete Construction of a Storage Barn On the Allan Farms Open Space Property

Whereas, the growth in the Town's parks and open space acreage has resulted in a need for more storage facilities at various locations throughout the Town;

Whereas, the Town's contracted agriculture farmers need additional storage space for their seasonal equipment and alfalfa/hay production;

Whereas, Town staff has identified the Allan Farms Open Space property as a suitable location to add a large prefabricated storage building that could house the Town's equipment and mowers, and temporarily store the agricultural production until it is sold;

Whereas, Town staff has recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the additional expenditure of \$80,000 from the Conservation Trust Fund to complete construction of a storage barn on the Allan Farms Open Space property; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and the public health, safety and welfare to approve such additional expenditure.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The expenditure of up to \$80,000 to complete construction of a storage barn on the Allan Farms Open Space property is hereby approved. Upon approval of the Town Attorney, the Town Administrator is authorized to execute any necessary contracts for the completion of the construction of the storage barn.
