NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Town's Board of Trustees (the "Board of Trustees") will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m.
or soon thereafter, on Tuesday, February 11, 2020 in the Town Hall
Board Room located at 645 Holbrook Street in Erie to review the
proposed Service Plan Amendment, and to form a basis for a resolution approving, disapproving or conditionally approving such
Service Plan Amendment. The Board of Trustees may, in its own
discretion, continue the hearing to a subsequent meeting.

The District consists of approximately one hundred fifty-seven (157) acres of residential land located entirely within the Town of Erie and is generally located north of Weld County Road 6 and west of Weld County Road 6.

The District was previously organized as a metropolitan district to finance the construction of certain public improvements and has the authority to impose a mill levy for repayment of debt and for limited administrative, operation and maintenance purposes. For debt service, the maximum mill levy that may be imposed by the District upon taxable property within the District's boundaries shall not exceed Fifty (50) mills. For operations and maintenance, the maximum mill levy limit that may be imposed by the District upon taxable property within the District's boundaries shall not exceed Ten (10) mills. If the method of calculating assessed valuation is changed by law, these maximum mill levies may be increased or decreased to reflect such changes.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any protests or objections to the District's proposed Service Plan Amendment must be submitted in writing to the Board of Trustees at or prior to the hearing, or any continuance or postponement thereof, in order to be considered. All protests and objections to the Service Plan Amendment, as proposed, shall be deemed waived unless presented in writing at the time and manner specified above.
