A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie Approving a Communications Site License Agreement with AT&T for the Installation of a New Light Pole with an Antenna to Improve Cellular Service in the Downtown Area

**Whereas,** the Town wishes to improve cellular service/coverage in the downtown area;

**Whereas,** the Town is the owner of the light pole identified by AT&T as an ideal location to place an antenna to improve cellular coverage/service;

**Whereas**, the Town and AT&T have negotiated an agreement whereby AT&T will install a new light pole and maintain an antenna and pay the Town annual payments for site lease of the light pole, and

**Whereas,** the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and the public health, safety and welfare to approve a Communications Site License Agreement with AT&T for the installation of a new light pole with an antenna to improve cellular service in the downtown area.

## Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Communications Site License Agreement with AT&T for the installation of a new light pole is hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to final approval by the Town Attorney. Upon such approval, the Mayor is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Town.
