Resolution No. 20-201**

**A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie Ratifying  
the Approval of the Additional Expenditure of a Portion of the  
Town's CARES Act Funding for Residential Utility Bill Credits**

**Whereas**, the Town recently received funding under the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act Funds");

**Whereas**, the Town is authorized to expend the CARES Act Funds in a manner necessary to respond to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic;

**Whereas**, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a widespread, detrimental economic impact on local residents;

**Whereas**, on October 27, 2020, the Town established a utility bill grant program to assist residents facing financial hardship as a result of COVID-19; and

**Whereas**, on November 12, 2020, the Town Administrator approved the allocation of additional funding to the utility bill grant program to continue to ensure the economic vitality and quality of life in the Town.

**Now therefore be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:**

**Section 1.** The Board of Trustees hereby ratifies the allocation of an additional \$60,000 of CARES Act funds to the utility bill grant program and the distribution of these funds to residents that qualify for funding under the program, in the form of credits against their residential utility bills.
