A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie Authorizing the Emergency Purchase of COVID Testing Stations from Thermal Safety Center and Savance, LLC with CARES Act Funds

Whereas, the Town recently received funding under the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act Funds");

Whereas, the Town is authorized to expend the CARES Act Funds in a manner necessary to respond to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic;

Whereas, the COVID-19 pandemic has had a widespread, detrimental economic impact on local residents;

Whereas, the Town wishes to COVID provide testing stations at all Town facilities;

Whereas, the purchase of COVID testing stations from Thermal Safety Center in the amount of \$61,700 and from Savance, LLC in the amount of \$36,800 will meet all the CARES Act reimbursement requirements; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and the public health, safety and welfare to approve the purchase of said items.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the purchase of COVID testing stations from Thermal Safety Center for \$61,700 and Savance, LLC for \$36,800 using CARES Act Funds.
