Incentives Overview


Mission: Support a robust, diverse and resilient economy by assisting small businesses and developers who contribute extraordinary value to Erie's economy and residents.


Action: Establish public-private partnerships to create new high-quality jobs, attract significant capital investment, diversify the local economy and enhance the overall quality of life for residents.

- Provision of Land and Property





Incentive Request

- Incentive request

- Pre-application meeting request

Incentive Negotiation

 Staff negotiates business incentive with applicant

Incentive Review

- Economic Impact Analysis
- Pre-application meeting
- Gap Feasibility Analysis

Incentive Agreement

- Staff finalizes incentive agreement
- Applicant submits formal letter

Incentive Approval

- \$100,000 <u>or more</u> staff presents to Town Council for approval
- \$100,000 <u>or less</u> staff presents to Town Manager for approval
