

**RESOLUTION 17-\_\_\_\_\_**

**A Resolution Authorizing a Contract With Design Workshop, Inc. for the I-25 & Erie Parkway Master Plan In The Amount of \$449,841.00; and, Setting Forth Details In Relation Thereto**

**WHEREAS**, On April 12, 2017, the Town released the I-25 & Erie Parkway Master Plan Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for a Master Plan that would cover the land located in Section 10 (within incorporated Erie) and Section 15 (Unincorporated Weld County) at the northwest corner of I-25 and Erie Parkway; and

**WHEREAS**, it was the intent of the RFQ process, for the Town to identify a partnership with the right consultant, and Town Staff has identified Design Workshop, Inc. as best fitting that need; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Erie, Colorado wishes to enter into a contract with Design Workshop, Inc. for the I-25 & Erie Parkway Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie believes it is in the best interest of the Town to enter into such a contract.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the contract between the Town of Erie and Design Workshop, Inc. is found to be a reasonable and acceptable contract for the I-25 & Erie Parkway Master Plan.

**Section 2.** That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the contract with Design Workshop, Inc. and the appropriate Town Officers are hereby authorized and directed to sign and bind the Town of Erie to said contract in an amount not to exceed \$449,841.00.

**Section 3.** That entering into the contract is found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
