Resolution No. 24-060**

**A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Erie Appointing Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C. as the Town's Municipal Prosecutor**

**Whereas**, pursuant to § 8.04 of the Town's Home Rule Charter, the Town Council wishes to appoint a Municipal Prosecutor;

**Whereas**, pursuant to § 8.04 of the Town's Home Rule Charter, the Municipal Prosecutor must be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado; and

**Whereas**, the law firm of Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C. employs attorneys licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado, and contracts with the Ausmus Law Firm, P.C. to provide municipal prosecution services, which firm also employs attorneys licensed to practice law in the State of Colorado.

**Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:**

**Section 1.** The Town Council hereby appoints Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C. as the Town's Municipal Prosecutor, with the understanding that the majority of municipal prosecution services will be performed by its subcontractor, the Ausmus Law Firm, P.C. Attorneys employed by Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C. may provide municipal prosecution services as necessary.

**Section 2.** The Town Council sets the compensation as follows: \$3,500 per month for all services performed by the Ausmus Law Firm, P.C.; and \$245 per hour for additional services provided by attorneys employed by Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C.
