**A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Erie Adopting the
Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Access Audit and Transition
Plan**

Whereas, the federal government enacted the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) as a comprehensive federal civil rights law prohibiting discrimination on the basis of disability; and

Whereas, the Town of Erie continually strives to ensure Town programs and services are accessible to everyone by maintaining and promoting facilities, services, and programs that are compliant with the ADA; and

Whereas, the Town of Erie undertook a self-evaluation and access audit of the programs and services offered at Town facilities for the creation of transition plan; and

Whereas, the access audit and transition plan provided the Town with an accurate assessment of the Town's facilities, services, and programs; and

Whereas, Town staff recommends the Town adopt the Access Audit and Transition Plan to assist with future planning for the Town's facilities, services, and programs.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The Access Audit and Transition Plan are hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to final approval by the Town Attorney and Town staff are directed to begin implementation of the same.
