Re: Legal Services for the Town of Erie Urban Renewal Authority

Dear Malcolm:

This letter is to express our interest in providing legal services to the Town of Erie Urban Renewal Authority ("TOEURA"). Pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-25-104(2)(c), the Erie Town Attorney is expressly authorized to act as the legal advisor to TOEURA, and that is what we would propose.

By way of background, Hoffmann, Parker, Wilson & Carberry, P.C. (formerly Hayes, Phillips, Hoffmann & Carberry, P.C.) was formed over 25 years ago with the specific goal of providing legal services to Colorado local governments. We currently represent over 25 different local governments in Colorado in various capacities, from general counsel to special counsel to hearing officer. Authority. Ms. Carberry currently represents the Vail Reinvestment Authority (the Town of Vail's urban renewal authority), the Superior Urban Renewal Authority and the Brighton Urban Renewal Authority.

Our rate for urban renewal authority representation is \$250 per hour. We also bill for out-of-pocket costs and travel time at ½ the hourly rate, as well as paralegal time at \$95 per hour.

Thank you for the opportunity to submit this letter of interest in representing TOEURA.


