**A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie
Approving the Distribution of Funds to the Downtown Erie
Business Association in the amount of \$11,100**

Whereas, the Downtown Erie Business Association ("DEBA") was established in 2020 with the purpose "to make Downtown Erie the most desirable place to visit, work, enjoy, and do business"; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to support the beautification efforts of DEBA for economic development and tourism purposes.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees hereby approves the distribution of funds to the Downtown Erie Business Association in the amount of \$11,100, to be used as follows:

- a. \$6,100 for patio expansion platform construction and materials;
- b. \$750 for the purchase of Americans with Disabilities Act compliant ramps to serve the newly constructed platforms;
- c. \$650 for holiday lights that will wrap the tree trunks on the 500 and 600 block of Briggs Street to provide additional lighting for pedestrians and patrons; and
- d. \$3,600 for flowers that will fill the 12 flower pots located in the 500 and 600 block of Briggs Street.
