Resolution No. 21-121**

**A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie  
Approving the Distribution of Funds to the Downtown Erie  
Business Association in the amount of \$74,632**

**Whereas**, the Downtown Erie Business Association ("DEBA") was established in 2020 with the purpose "to make Downtown Erie the most desirable place to visit, work, enjoy, and do business"; and

**Whereas**, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to support the beautification efforts of DEBA for economic development and tourism purposes.

**Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:**

**Section 1.** The Board of Trustees hereby approves the distribution of funds to the Downtown Erie Business Association in the amount of \$74, 632, to be used as follows:

- a. \$20,000 for September & October Briggs Street concerts;
- b. \$36,850 for entering into a two-year contract with Colorado Christmas Lights to expand the coverage area of Holiday Lights;
- c. \$16,782 for park benches and receptacles on the 500 and 600 block of Briggs along with the Wells and Cheesman blocks; and
- d. \$1,000 for the creation of the Downtown Gift Card program to support Downtown businesses.
