Town of Erie Ordinance No. 02-2025

An Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Erie Filling One Vacancy on the Board of Directors of the Four Corners Business Improvement District

Whereas, by Ordinance 29-2016, the Town established the Four Corners Business Improvement District (the "BID") pursuant to the Business Improvement District Act, C.R.S. § 31-25-1202, *et seq.*;

Whereas, the Town Council established the initial Board of Directors of the BID by appointing 5 electors of the BID as provided in C.R.S. § 31-25-1202, *et seq.*; and

Whereas, the BID has asked the Town Council to appoint one individual who has been qualified as an elector under C.R.S. § 31-25-1203(4)(a) to fill the vacancy pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-25-1209(1)(b).

Now Therefore be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Erie, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1. Appointment. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 31-25-1209(1)(b), the following elector of the BID is hereby appointed to the Board of Directors of the BID, to serve at the pleasure of the Town Council: Walter Pounds.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one, or part, or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3. Safety. The Town Council finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication following adoption.
