**A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie
Approving an Intergovernmental Funding Agreement with
Boulder County**

Whereas, reducing energy use in directly supports the Town's sustainability and planning goals, and ensures that the impacts of energy use and mineral extraction industries within and surrounding the Town is mitigated to the greatest extent possible;

Whereas, a collaborative approach to updating building codes, addressing climate impacts, focusing on affordability, equity, and resilience, and improving indoor/outdoor air quality recognizes that one single community cannot achieve a better built environment, prevent climate disruption, and mitigate energy impacts alone; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees recognizes the urgency and community-wide benefits of addressing energy use in the built environment through the adoption of the 2021 International Energy Conservation Codes, with strengthening amendments, as well as the adoption of Net Zero New Construction Roadmaps.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement between the Town and Boulder County for funding in the amount of \$10,000 is hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to final approval by the Town Attorney. Upon such approval, the Mayor is authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the Town.
