	 The Resolution does two things: 1. Establishes that the Board of Trustees finds the Annexation Petition to be in substantial compliance with the laws of the State of Colorado.
	 Sets a Public Hearing date and time of October 22, 2019, at 6:30pm, in the Erie Town Hall, 645 Holbrook Street, Erie, CO 80516.
Purpose:	The Zilis Annexation petition requests annexation to the Town of Erie of a parcel of land approximately 4.40 acres in size.

Location: The subject property is located along the south side of Jasper Road approximately 0.32 of a mile east of North 119th Street and is generally described as a portion of the NW ¼ of Section 13, Township 1 North, Range 69 West of the 6th Principle Meridian.
