Affordable housing is spending less than 30% of your annual income on housing

Cost burdened families are paying 40-50%

Contributes to a \$2 billion loss in the community

How can Government help?


Government Regulation

> Fewer Zoning Requirements


Targeted Universalism

- Targeted goals so the whole population can strive to get there






Where is Erie Now?




Erie's Current Goals
