Resolution No. 22-112**

**A Resolution of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie  
Rescinding the Declaration of a Local Disaster Emergency  
Concerning the COVID-19 Pandemic in and for the Town of Erie**

**Whereas**, on March 14, 2020, Mayor Jennifer Carroll declared a local disaster emergency in and for the Town of Erie, Colorado, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, § 24-33.5-701, *et seq.* (the "Act") and the Erie Municipal Code (the "Code"), Title 1, Chapter 8;

**Whereas**, on April 28, 2020, the Board of Trustees continued indefinitely the declaration of a local disaster emergency; and

**Whereas**, the emergency conditions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, as defined by C.R.S. § 24-33.5-702, no longer persist and no longer require additional and sustained action by the Town.

**Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:**

Section 1. Mayor Jennifer Carroll's emergency declaration of a disaster emergency in and for the Town of Erie is hereby rescinded and terminated.

Section 2. Pursuant to C.R.S. § 24-33.5-709(1), this Order shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Town Clerk, the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder, the Weld County Clerk and Recorder and the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
