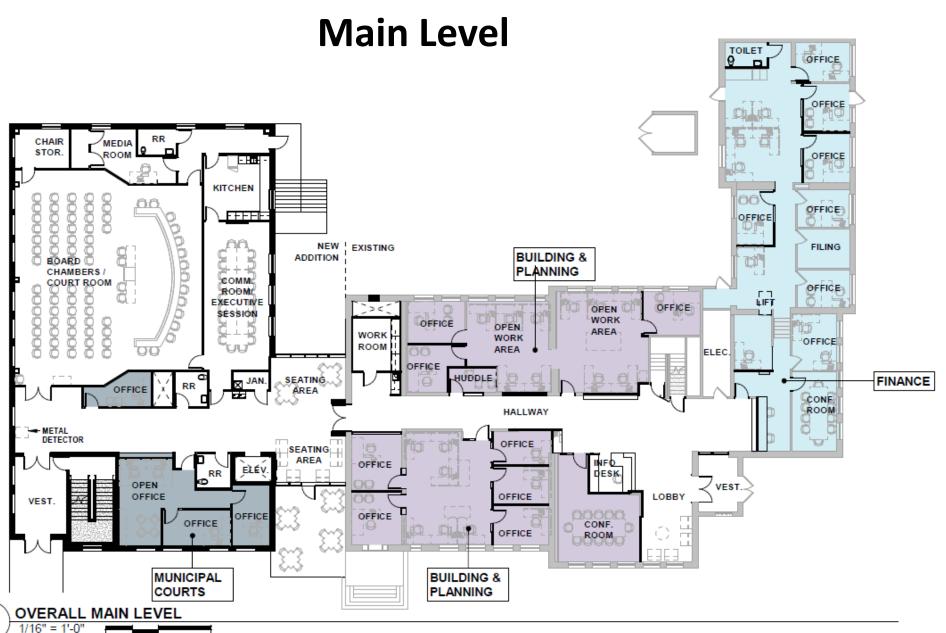


February 28 Board Discussion & Direction

Board Discussion:

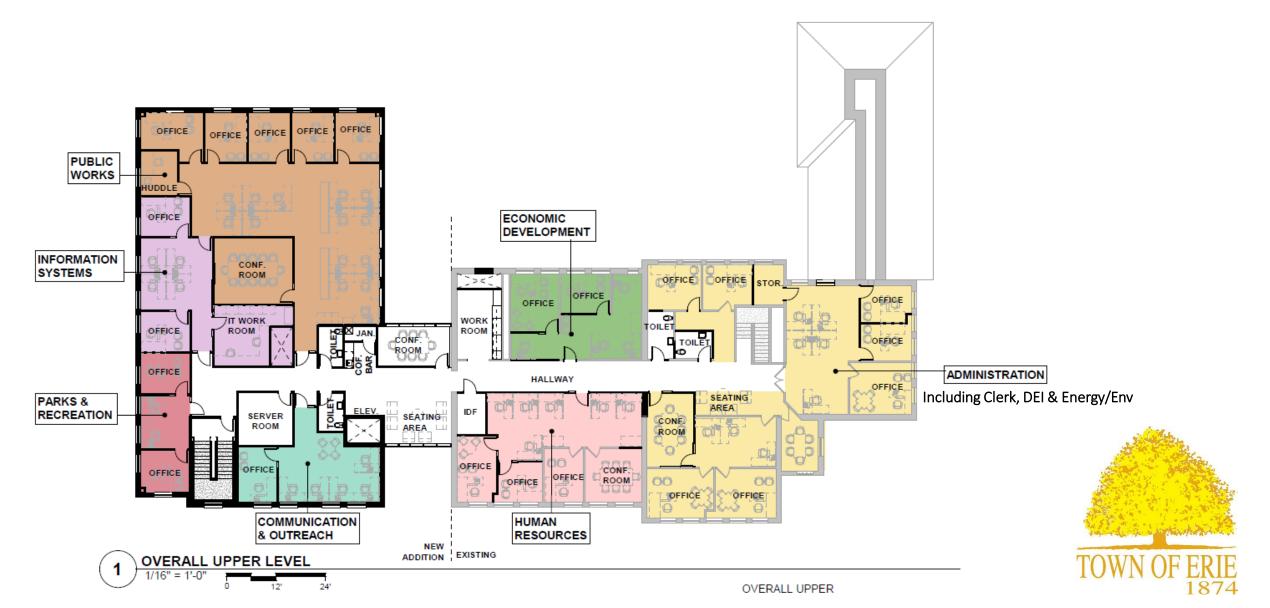
- Building an entirely new building in a different location for an additional \$7 million.
 Staff noted that would involve getting voter approval for new funding or drawing down General Fund reserves below the current level required by Board policy.
- Certificates of participation (COPs). A funding option, but more expensive than funding as proposed.
- Currently being at 70% design and if this plan is not approved, we will lose some of that work.
- Plan will provide 10-15 years of space in a format that provides flexible spaces
- Conservative forecast estimates of future revenue
- Parking issues and need for Downtown parking management
- Assessment of having Municipal Court in Town Hall: "It will be awesome."
- Board Direction: provide more detail on 3-story new addition to and full renovation of Town Hall & come back with funding plan.



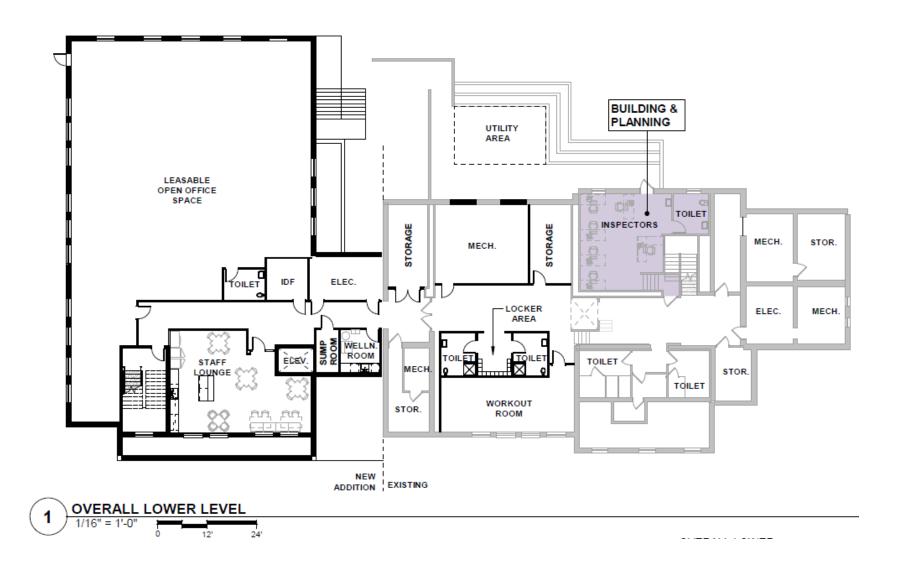




Upper Level



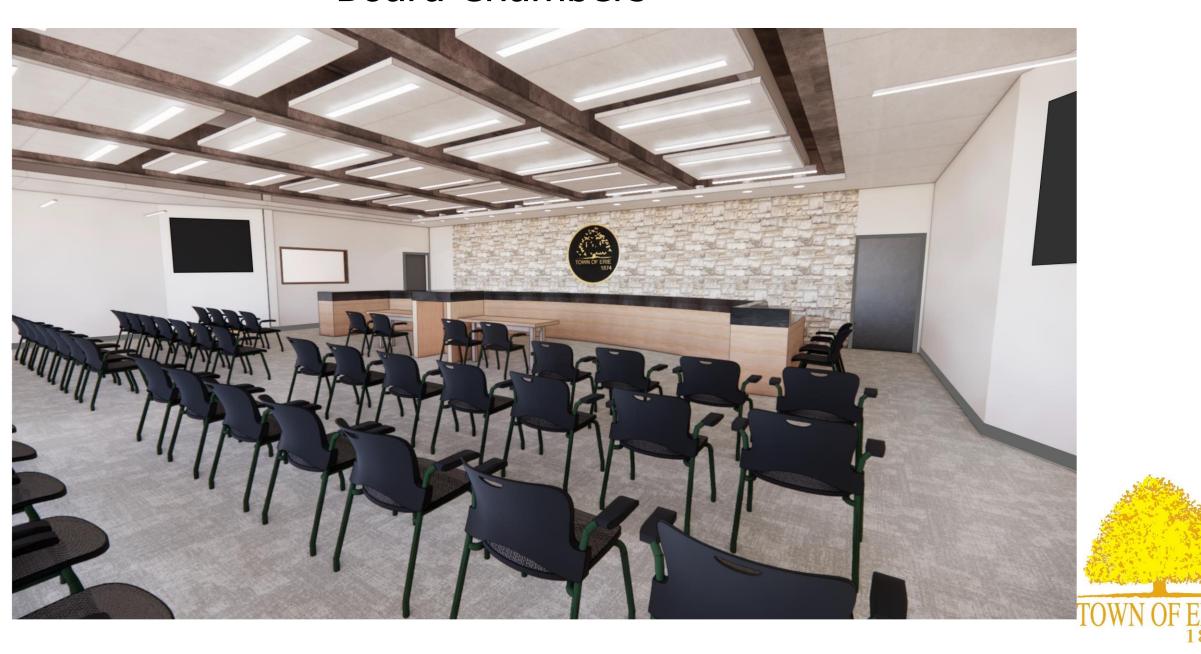
Lower Level



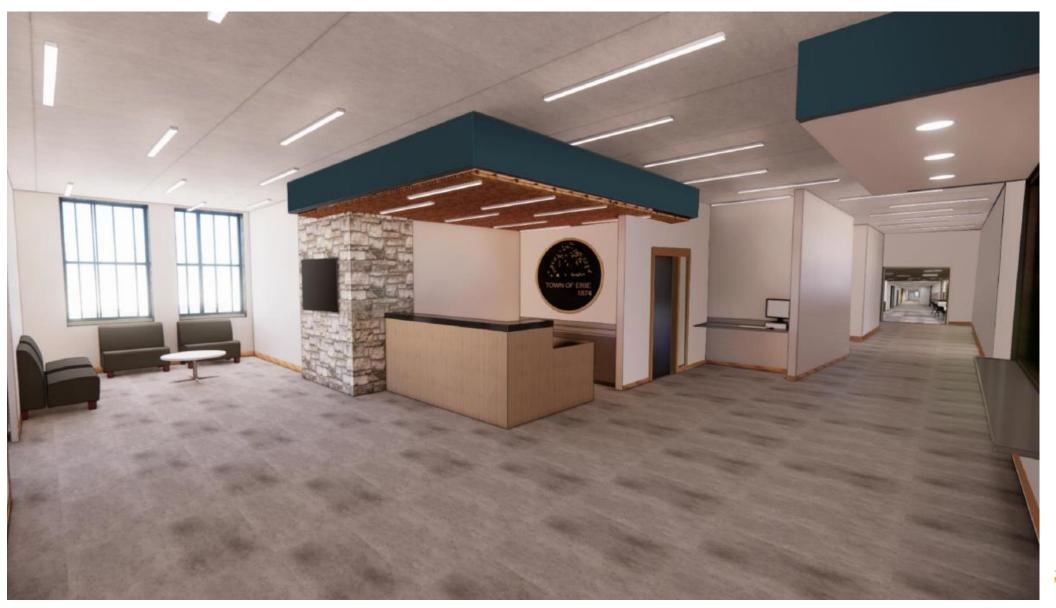

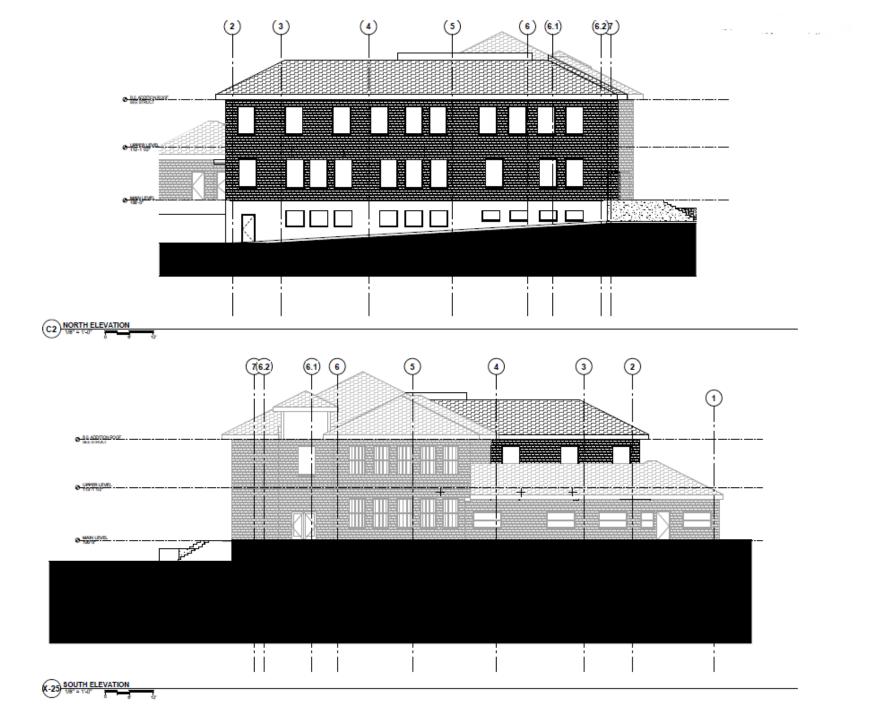














Project Schedule

- Groundbreaking: November 2023
- New Building complete: December 2024
- Renovation starts: December 2024
- Renovation complete: August 2025



Benefits of this expansion plan...

- Maintains the Town Hall presence in Historic Downtown Erie
- Brings Town Hall up to current building code and ADA compliance
- Accommodates existing and anticipated staff as the Town grows
- Creates open lobby and service counters for enhanced customer service
- Makes better use of elevator and the north stairwell and eliminates safety hazard
- Enables Court in Town Hall, making better use of the Board Chambers
- Enables more cost-effective Police Department expansion
- Finishing 1st floor will cost less than in future (due to mobilization and inflation costs)
- Provides office, operations, and public space we need for 10-15 years
- Increases employee safety, comfort, and employee morale
- Improves aesthetics and presence of Historic Town Hall

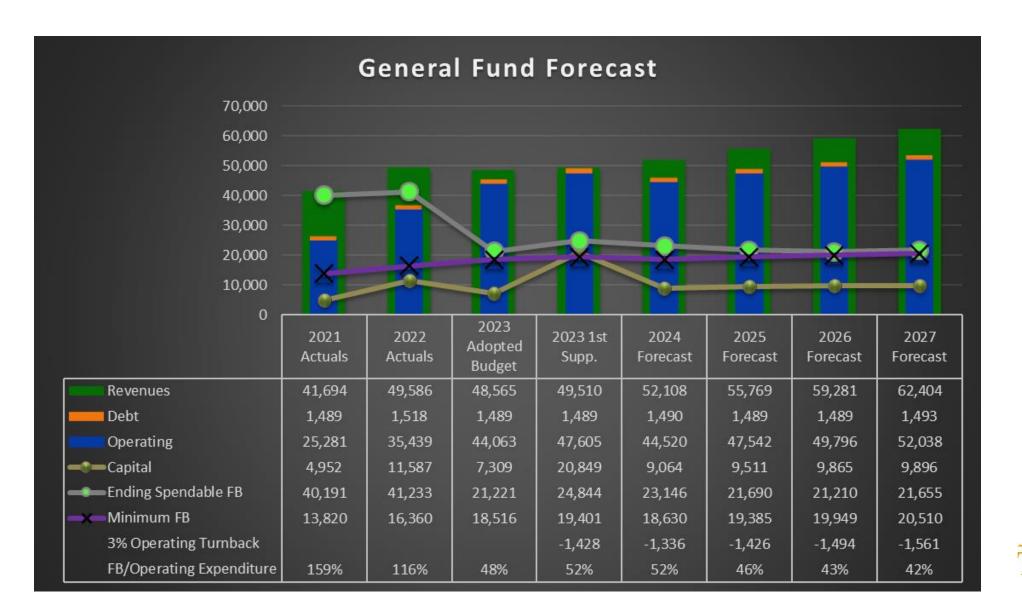
