

RESOLUTION NO. 16-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ERIE AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO CONCRETE STABILIZATION TECHNOLOGIES, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$101,933.00 AND A CHANGE ORDER TO A SERVICE CONTRACT FOR ASPHALT REPAIRS TO METRO PAVERS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,600.00; FOR THE VISTA PARKWAY BRIDGE REPAIR PROJECT; AND SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Erie, Colorado wishes to award a Construction Contract to Concrete Stabilization Technologies, Inc., in the amount of \$101,933.00 and a Change Order to a Service Contract for asphalt repairs to Metro Pavers, Inc. in the amount of \$9,600.00; for the Vista Parkway Bridge Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie believes it is in the best interest of the Town to enter into such contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the contract between the Town of Erie and Concrete Stabilization Technologies, Inc. is found to be a reasonable and acceptable contract for the Vista Parkway Bridge Repair Project.

Section 2. That the change order to a service contract for asphalt repairs between the Town of Erie and Metro Pavers, Inc. is found to be reasonable and acceptable for the Vista Parkway Bridge Repair Project.

Section 3. That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the contract with Concrete Stabilization Technologies, Inc. and the Appropriate Town Officers are hereby authorized and directed to sign and bind the Town of Erie to said contract in the amount of \$101,933.00 with a contingency not to exceed \$15,292.00.

Section 4. That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a change order to a service contract for asphalt repairs with Metro Pavers, Inc. and the Appropriate Town Officers are hereby authorized and directed to sign and bind the Town of Erie to said contract in the amount of \$9,600.00 with a contingency not to exceed \$1,440.00.

Section 5. That these contracts are found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
