

Summary:

The Resolution, provided for consideration by the Board of Trustees, accepts dedications on the plat and authorizes the appropriate town official to sign the plat and Flatiron Meadows Filing No. 9 Development Agreement which outlines obligations of the Town and the Owners for Flatiron Meadows Filing No. 9, Final Plat.

Project Description:

The Flatiron Meadows Filing No. 9 Final Plat creates 117 single family lots, 5 tracts and associated rightof-ways on 81.716 acres.

Project Process:

The Community Development Director and Public Works Director have conditionally approved the Flatiron Meadows Filing No. 9 Final Plat, contingent upon the acceptance of the dedications, and development agreement by the Board of Trustees and the filing of appropriate documents with Town staff.
