A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, TO ENTER INTO ENCROACHMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH BOULDER VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A FIBER OPTIC LINE ON TOWN PROPERTY AND IN THE TOWN RIGHT-OF-WAY; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICERS TO SIGN SAID ENCROACHMENT LICENSE AGREEMENT; AND, SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Erie, Colorado wishes to enter into Encroachment License Agreement with Boulder Valley School District for Construction of a Fiber Optic Line on Town Property and in the Town Right-of-Way; and

<u>Section 3.</u> That entering into the Encroachment License Agreement is found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
