A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BOULDER; THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE; THE CITY OF LONGMONT; THE CITY OF LOUISVILLE; THE TOWN OF LYONS; THE TOWN OF NEDERLAND; THE TOWN OF SUPERIOR AND BOULDER COUNTY, SUPPORTING THE TOWN OF ERIE'S PARTICIPATION IN THE BOULDER COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FORUM; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICERS TO SIGN SAID INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT; AND SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Intergovernmental Agreement among the Town of Erie and the City of Boulder; the City of Lafayette; the City of Longmont; the City of Louisville; the Town of Lyons; the Town of Nederland; the Town of Superior and Boulder County is found to reasonable and acceptable for the purpose of supporting the Town's participation in the Boulder County Transportation Improvement Program Forum.
