

**RESOLUTION NO. 18-\_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO BOULDER COUNTY FOR EMERGENCY DISPATCH SERVICES PROVIDED TO THE TOWN OF ERIE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2018 CALENDAR YEAR IN THE AMOUNT OF \$101,500.00; AND SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Erie has an agreement with the Boulder County Sheriff's Communications Department to provide emergency dispatching services to the Erie Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the Erie Police Department budgets each year for this service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie believes it is in the best interest of the Town to make said payment to Boulder County to provide emergency dispatch services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the fees for providing emergency dispatch services for the 2018 calendar year is found to be reasonable and acceptable.

Section 2. That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to make payment to Boulder County in the amount of \$101,500.00 and the appropriate Town Officers are hereby authorized and directed to execute the expenditures of funds.

Section 3. That authorizing payment for emergency dispatch services for the Erie Police Department is found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
