RESOLUTION NO. ____-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR MUNICIPAL JAIL SERVICES WITH WELD COUNTY; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICERS TO SIGN SAID AGREEMENT, SUBJECT TO THE FINAL APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT BY THE TOWN'S CHIEF OF POLICE AND TOWN ATTORNEY; AND, SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Erie, Colorado wishes to enter into an Agreement for Municipal Jail Services with Weld County for the purpose of using the Weld County Jail for the confinement or punishment of offenders; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie believes it is in the best interest of the Town to enter into such an Agreement for Municipal Jail Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Agreement for Municipal Jail Services between the Town of Erie and Weld County, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is found to be a reasonable and acceptable agreement for the provision of jail services to the Town.

Section 2. That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the Agreement for Municipal Jail Services, and the appropriate Town officers are hereby authorized and directed to sign and bind the Town of Erie to said Agreement, subject to and conditioned upon the approval of the final version of the Agreement, as approved by the Town's Chief of Police and Town Attorney.

<u>Section 3.</u> That entering into the Agreement for Municipal Jail Services is found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
