

ORDINANCE NO. 18-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, REVISING TITLE 7, "PUBLIC WAYS AND PROPERTY," CHAPTER 6, "PARK AND RECREATION FACILITY REGULATIONS," SECTION 7-6-5.V, ENTITLED "REGULATIONS," OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF ERIE AND, SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to amend the Town of Erie Municipal Code as set forth herein below, and that such an amendment is necessary to the preservation of the public property, health, safety, and welfare of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Title 7, "Public Ways and Property," Chapter 6, "Park and Recreation Facility Regulations," Section 7-6-5.V. of the Municipal Code of the Town of Erie, entitled "Regulations," is hereby revised to read as follows:

7-6-5: REGULATIONS

In the use of any parks or recreation facilities, all persons shall comply with all the regulations of this chapter and it shall be unlawful for any person to:

V. Use any projectile weapon, including, but not limited to, any firearm, gas or mechanically operated gun, sling, paintball gun, bow and arrow, or similar type device that shoots any type of projectile therefrom. With the exception of firearms, the use of a projectile weapons may be authorized by the parks and recreation director, or designee, at any town sponsored event.

Terms used herein are defined at Section 6-1-1 of this code.

Section 2. Severance Clause. If an article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie, Colorado hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3. Repeal. All other ordinances, or parts of any ordinances or other Code provisions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication following final passage.
