#### Abstract

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A CONSULTANT CONTRACT TO BURNS \& MCDONNEL INC. FOR THE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY EXPANSION DESIGN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$459,116.00 AND A CONTINGENCY AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$65,884.00; AND SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN RELATION THERETO.


WHEREAS, the Town of Erie, Colorado wishes to award a Consultant Contract to Burns \& McDonnel Inc. for the Water Treatment Facility Expansion Design in the amount of $\$ 459,116.00$ and a contingency amount not to exceed \$65,884.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Erie believes it is in the best interest of the Town to enter into such contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The 2018 Wastewater Capital Improvement budget contains funds for design of the next expansion of the Lynn R. Morgan Water Treatment Facility.

Section 2. That the contracts between the Town of Erie and Burns \& McDonnel Inc. are found to be reasonable and acceptable contracts for the next expansion of the Lynn R. Morgan Water Treatment Facility.

Section 3. That the Town of Erie be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contracts with Burns \& McDonnel Inc. and the Appropriate Town Officers are hereby authorized and directed to sign and bind the Town of Erie to said contract in the amount of $\$ 459,116.00$ and a contingency amount not to exceed $\$ 65,884.00$.

Section 4. That this consultant contract is found to be in the best interest of the Town of Erie, and necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety.
