SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

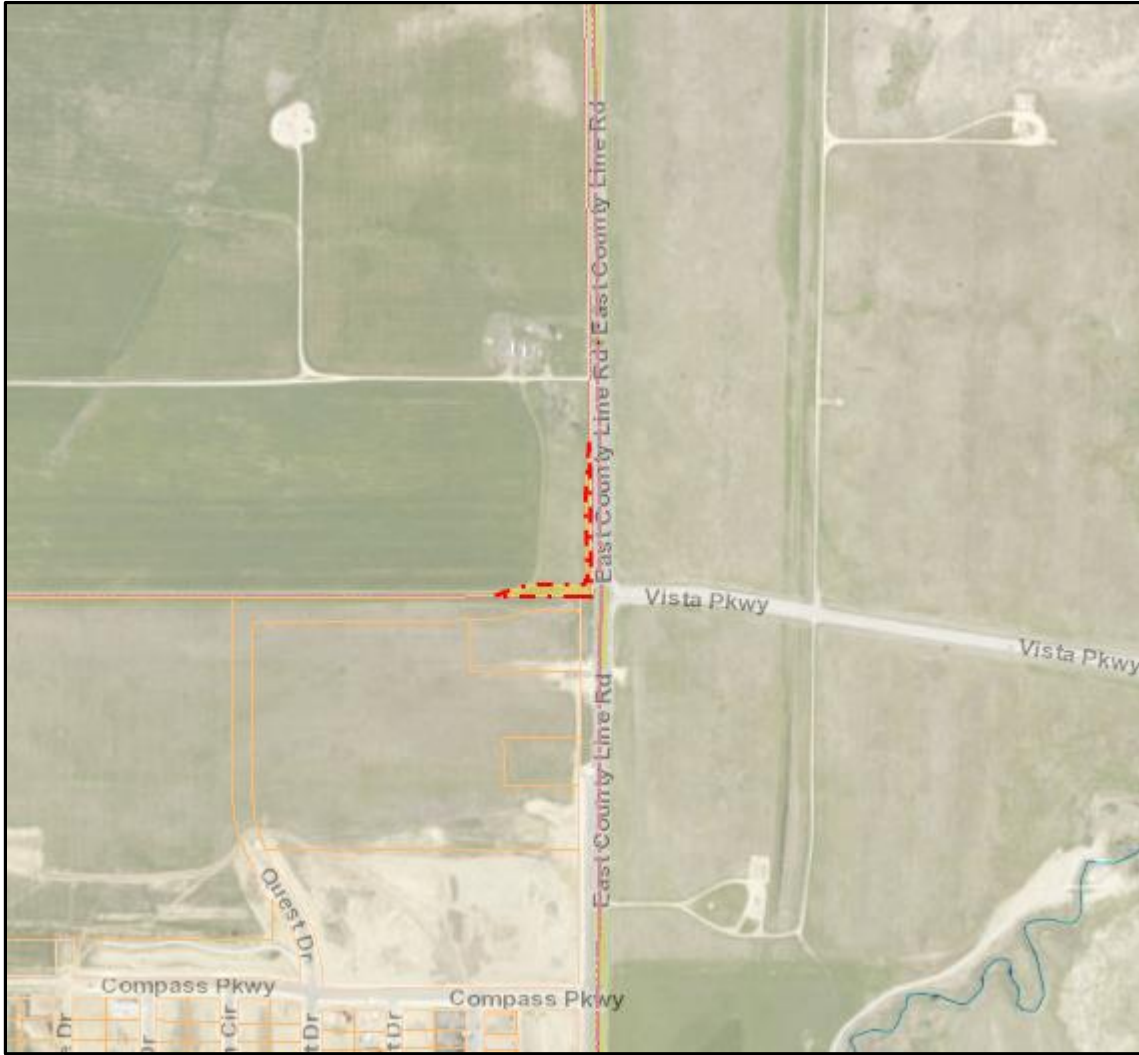

Requested Action: Acceptance of the Annexation Petition for Erie Farms Annexation and the setting of a public hearing for said annexation.
The Resolution does two things:

1. Establishes that the Board of Trustees finds the Annexation Petition to be in substantial compliance with the laws of the State of Colorado.
2. Sets a Public Hearing date and time of August 14, 2018, at 6:30 p.m., in the Erie Town Hall, 645 Holbrook, Erie, CO 80516.

Purpose: The Erie Farms Annexation petition requests annexation to the Town of Erie of an approximate 0.389 acre parcel.

Location: The subject property is located along the west side of County Line Road approximately 0.50 miles south of Bonnell Ave. and is generally described as a portion of Section 25, Township 1 North, Range 69 West of the 6th Principle Meridian. The site is highlighted in red below.



Existing Zoning: A – Agricultural (Boulder County)

Size: Approximately 0.389 acres
