**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF  
ERIE ADOPTING THE BOULDER COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH  
ORDER REQUIRING FACE COVERINGS IN PUBLIC WHERE SOCIAL  
DISTANCING CANNOT BE MAINTAINED**

**WHEREAS**, on April 28, 2020, the Board of Trustees continued indefinitely the declaration of a local disaster emergency in the Town of Erie, pursuant to the Town's authority under the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. § 24-33.5-701, *et seq.* (the "Act");

**WHEREAS**, the basis for the emergency declaration, the COVID-19 pandemic, continues;

**WHEREAS**, on May 2, 2020, the Boulder County Board of Health issued an order requiring face coverings in public where social distancing cannot be maintained, a copy of which is attached hereto (the "Boulder County Order");

**WHEREAS**, Weld County has not issued a similar order;

**WHEREAS**, on May 4, Mayor Jennifer Carroll extended the Boulder County Order to all parts of Erie;

**WHEREAS**, on May 22, 2020, the Boulder County Order was extended through June 30, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare by preventing the further spread of COVID-19.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, THAT:**

**Section 1.** Effective immediately and remaining in effect through June 30, 2020, each of the requirements of the Boulder County Order shall apply throughout the Town of Erie, in both Boulder County and Weld County.

**Section 2.** This Order shall be given prompt and general publicity, filed immediately with the Town Clerk, and a copy of it shall be sent to the Boulder County Clerk and Recorder, the Weld County Clerk and Recorder and the Colorado Office of Emergency Management.
