**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
ERIE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
BOULDER COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF ERIE CONCERNING
BOULDER COUNTY SHARING COLLECTED DATA FROM RETRAC
WITH THE TOWN OF ERIE ANNUALLY.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Erie Board of Trustees adopted an Ordinance to require Waste Haulers to obtain licenses through, and require haulers to submit annual reports to, the Boulder County Resource Conservation Division; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Erie will begin collecting baseline waste diversion data through a standardized online reporting system; and

WHEREAS, this data is crucial for making responsible, data-driven decisions to achieve recycling and composting priorities adopted in the Sustainability Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the best interest of the Town and the public health, safety and welfare to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with Boulder County for sharing collected data from ReTRAC annually with the Town of Erie.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
TOWN OF ERIE, COLORADO, THAT:**

Section 1. The Intergovernmental Agreement with Boulder County concerning Boulder County sharing collected data from ReTRAC annually with the town of Erie is hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to final approval by the Town Attorney. Upon such approval, the Mayor is authorized to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the Town.
