
Staff is recommending the Town Board of Trustees set the public hearing date for the proposed Hammer Annexation.

SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

Land Owner:	Anadarko E&P Company LP 1099 18 th St., Suite 1800 Denver, CO 80202
Requested Action:	Acceptance of the Annexation Petition for the Hammer Annexation and the setting of a public hearing for said annexation.
	 The Resolution does two things: 1. Establishes that the Board of Trustees finds the Annexation Petition to be in substantial compliance with the laws of the State of Colorado.
	 Sets a Public Hearing date and time of June 22, 2021, at 6:30pm, in the Erie Town Hall, 645 Holbrook Street, Erie, CO 80516.
Purpose:	The Hammer Annexation petition requests annexation to the Town of Erie of a parcel of land approximately 47 acres in size.

Location:

The subject property is generally located southwest of the Highway 52 and Interstate 25 intersection. Specifically, it is located at the NE corner of the WCR 7 and WCR 12 intersection. The annexation area is approximately 47 acres in size. The site is highlighted in red below.
