### Hurdles and Way Forward to Reverse Trend

### Hurdles of Landmarking

- Myths floating around about stringent criteria and regulations or Landmarking
- Secretary of Interior Standards are more directed towards State/National requirements
- Lack of Public Awareness & Outreach
- Millennial Generation Gap of ownership
- Economic Development Pressure
- No Recognized codes for Landmark Properties
- Limited Skill Base of contractors
- Lack of Local Governmental Support
- Lack of tax credit for maintaining historic properties
- Historic Board on steep learning curve

### Way Forward

- Approve Tax Credit program for historic property owners
- Continue public outreach program (schools, associations and organizations)
- Incorporate Design Guidelines into UDC
- Create Local criteria for properties which has minimal changes
- Conduct workshop on home repairs
- Source and maintain database of certified contractors
