Tree Talks 9/25 & 10/16

Art showed us the final poster

Starts at 6:30pm. Art will be there at 6pm and he sends them the room setup plan. Cookies and water provided. Someone needs to introduce Mike and say a few things about the tree board. There can be some info about what we've done on the board as well. Leanne can introduce Mike. Same script as last year. We had a sign in sheet and a questionnaire last time. Leanne will create a large poster board where people can tick off topics that they are interested in learning more about (as opposed to a personal questionnaire to fill out). Decision not to worry about giving a tree away this time - maybe in the future.

Leaf Composting 11/3 & 11/18

Potential times: 9am - 3pm. Which will give us time to finish up at the end of the day. Volunteer time will likely go later. Really didn't have time to man a booth with pamphlets.

Four bins this time. Separated in case we need to move sites as areas get filled up. Need to know if we have two sets of risers, with riser between two bins.

As far as requesting funds, can request funds from Sandy for volunteer groups to make donations to them for help. Up to \$500. Could be \$250 for two groups that offer 20 people to help. We need to secure the groups. We have volunteer sign up forms. Could include boy scout group or any other group

ideas. Sustainability board will meet tomorrow. We will tell them our preferred times. We can have up to two people to help coordinate with the Sustainability board. Art will send them the information. Art is the point person to coordinate. Leanne can help coordinate.

Volunteer groups - how many do we need to have volunteer to be donated the money? Art recommends approximately 20 people. Volunteers need to be tall/strong enough to lift bags. May recommend high schoolers and up rather than elementary school aged kids.

How many people do we need for each kind of job? Notes from last year on people we need

• Need 2 people on platform, 1-2 people untying bags and putting them on platform, 1-2 unloading bags from cars, 1-2 people stomping leaves in bin, 1 person to handle empty bags, 1 person as runner/floater.

We should request traffic cones. Can cone up the preferred route to the preferred bin. Could potentially request money for lunch. Nearest bathroom is at the dog park. Should we request a port-a-potty? Yes!

Art assembling a list of things we need.

3 hour shifts for staff. Wait until Sustainability finalizes the event, then we can figure out what to do for volunteers.
