#### GENERAL BUSINESS

Low Water / Native Plant Resolution Rocky Mountain Audubon - phone conference to discuss a project CSU students did.

Daly Edmunds - Director of Policy and Outreach Jaime Weiss - Habitat Hero Coordinator

They have ideas for implementation. Maps showing connected habitats and habitat hero gardens and neighborhoods. Ideas for demonstration gardens with native plants, outreach activities, and science-backed policy.

Habitat Heros - work with individuals to maximize native plants to create small habitat habits for birds, butterflies, etc to rebuild and restore the fractured landscape one garden at a time. Has a certification program. There are no Habitat Hero gardens in Erie currently.

How can Audubon Rocky Mountain help with responsible development and promote that for other communities?

Planning - be a part of strategic planning process, attend meetings, leverage connections with other partners. CSU spatial planting is one example. Students tasked for mapping areas with rich habitats. Erie had a corridor of rich habitat area running north to south while other communities have structures and building in the middle of town and wildlife areas on the edges of town. Can also help with plant lists and put up demonstration gardens.

Art would like to see if the Audubon members in Erie would be willing to participate. Audubon itself can contact these members and notify them of events.

Tom will send us the CSU student project. Has put files on the Tree Board Sharepoint drive. Website: http://rockies.audubon.org/habitat-hero

Christiaan will bring the resolution to the Board of Trustees and remind the Town Administrator. Note that the Arborist position has not yet been

filled. Christiaan recommended a couple of Tree Board members to meet

informally to the Town Administrator to explain the vision and what we hope to accomplish. Art suggests meeting with Malcolm with 1 or 2 members of each of the 3 boards (Tree, Sustainability, OSTAB).

#### Arbor / Earth Day 2019 Event Retrospective

Food - A few bags of fruit remained at the end so could use less fruit in the future.

Coffee - two cambros were filled.

Chair options - recommend having a single main chair with subcommittee chairs to handle aspects of the event such as food/drink, marketing/advertising, poster contest, etc. This will enable us to add on the event as we just need to designate someone as a lead of that new component. Tree Board should be primary chair since we are required to hold the Arbor Day event and are ultimately responsible for it.

#### 110 raffle tickets distributed.

How to handle one-ticket per household? Recommend having a sign next to the raffle ticket distributor. We just verbally told people but that isn't the most effective. They were in the announcements but were hard to hear.

Mike McGill mentioned previously that staff members would like to rotate the event each year. Art suggests - that we need to take the size of the park into account to ensure that we can support the number of exhibitors. Also has ramifications for back-up location. Who decides what the location should be?

## Great American Tree Competition

No one has time to address this this year. However it happens every year and this is the fourth year. Part of the American Grove organization. They have a newsletter. Might be a good way to engage the community via social media to think about our community trees. People just submit pictures and information about their favorite community trees, including height to the contest.

Tom - would also like to highlight landmark trees in Town.

## Tree Talk

Tree talk this Saturday 10:30-noon - at Kenosha area Crescent Park. Several potential planting sites. Mike McGill will bring planting handouts as well as shovels but Art doesn't know how many trees will be planted. Would like to provide educational literature of how to debug tree issues during planting before the tree distribution next year.

At prior indoor tree talks - there was cookies and water. Should we offer that with an outdoor digging event.

Leanne - cookies and water probably shouldn't be expected - a nice gesture. Art will see if there is a water fountain.

Tree Board members should be there by 10am with Tree Board shirts on.

School Outreach

Email report from Brian: As of last night, I will be using the tree seed planting kits for a Soaring Heights event, interacting with about 110 kids

Tree Buying Program

Boulder County program - since we have interest - they have 31 trees available to any Erie resident. Art ordered one and then they said we have 100 trees available and we can tell neighbors. Art told Tasha Reynolds about it and Art recommended she open it to town staff since number is small. Pick-ups are immediate. Website is http://energysavingtrees.arborday.org.

Tasha is managing the town tree incentive program and is looking into changing the voucher program because there are discomforts with how that is handled now. She is interested in working with us. Art and Tom will meet with her.
