  - Tuesday: Fort Collins approved a plastics ban. Can SAB propose a similar voter ballot for Erie by November? Trustee Van Woudenberg to reach out to Fort Collins for next steps.

- Can we take the temperature of the community? Have a question on the Town survey.
- Need to dig into details and how the transition will work.
- Might be a good idea to start with single-use plastic ban and then expand to other plastics.
- **Action item: Trustee Van Woudenberg to see what happens in Fort Collins and Louisville and report next month**
- **Industry-scale solar on the landfill.** Trustee Loflin working on the idea on utility-scale solar. Discuss during the Colorado Solar and Storage Summit happening in April 2021. Malcolm, Todd, and Tyler have submitted a questionnaire.
  - Airport board has reached out about solar on their buildings
- Looking for the possibility of Erie composting site.
