## SUMMARY AND BACKGROUND OF SUBJECT MATTER:

On July 18, 2018, the Board of Trustees adopted Ordinance No. 20-2018, which imposed a temporary moratorium on the acceptance, processing, and approval of any application related to oil and gas exploration, extraction, and related operations. The Town of Erie's current temporary moratorium expires on February 20, 2019.

Since July 18, 2018, the Town of Erie has investigated regulatory practices, and has begun revisions of the Town's regulations related to oil and gas development.

The 2019 session of Colorado General Assembly has begun, and it is anticipated that the Colorado General Assembly will enact oil and gas legislation that may broaden municipal authority over oil and gas development.

Rather than adopt revised regulations now, the Board of Trustees finds it in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to extend the temporary moratorium for an additional six months to await the enactment of new legislation.
