### **SECOND AMENDMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT CO-RESPONDER SERVICES**

This SECOND AMENDMENT (“Amendment”) to the Intergovernmental Agreement for Co-Responder Services with a start date of January 1, 2024 (“IGA”) is entered into between the Board of County Commissioners of Boulder County on behalf of the County of Boulder, State of Colorado, a body corporate and politic, for the benefit of the Community Services Department (“County”) and Town of Erie, a State of Colorado municipality (the “Municipality”).

1. Modifications. Section 4 of the IGA is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:  
“4. Payment for Services. In consideration of the Services performed by the County during calendar year 2026, and subject to the conditions contained in this IGA, the Municipality will pay an amount not to exceed \$236,637.41”
2. Effective Date. This Amendment is effective as of January 1, 2026.
3. Limits of Effect. The IGA and all prior amendments, if any, remain in full force and effect except as specifically modified by this Amendment.
