Whereas, effective child abuse prevention programs succeed because of partnerships among families, social service agencies, schools, religious and civic organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community; and

Whereas, the Town of Erie Town Council hereby encourages our community to support efforts ensuring every child grows up in a safe, nurturing environment – free from harm and fear.

Now therefore, the Town Council does hereby proclaim April 2026 to be Child Abuse Prevention Month and urge every resident to recognize our community is stronger through awareness.

We further call upon all community members of Erie to observe the week of April 19-25, 2026, as Crime Victims' Rights Week in honor of those dedicated victim service providers who are working every day to meet the needs of crime victims.
