Resolution No. 26-072**

A Resolution of the Town Council of the Town of Erie Approving a License Agreement with the City of Lafayette for a Temporary Detour of the Coal Creek Regional Trail

Whereas, the City of Lafayette owns a parcel of land located generally on the northeast corner of East County Line Road and East Baseline Road, with a street address of 750 East County Line Road, Lafayette, CO 80026, and operates a portion of its Water Reclamation Facility;

Whereas, the Town owns real property located directly east of and adjacent to the Lafayette Property;

Whereas, a regional pedestrian trail traverses the Lafayette Property;

Whereas, Lafayette must temporarily close the segment of the regional trail to the public to accommodate construction of floodplain improvements within the Coal Creek riparian corridor adjacent to the Lafayette Water Reclamation Facility; and

Whereas, the Parties wish to allow the public access to the Town's property in order to serve as a detour for the regional trail during the closure of the Lafayette Property.

Now Therefore be it Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Erie, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The License Agreement with the City of Lafayette is hereby approved in substantially the form attached hereto, subject to final approval of the Town Attorney. Upon such approval, the Mayor is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the Town.
