Ordinance No. 021-2026

**An Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Erie Adopting
and Amending the Town's Purchasing Policy**

Whereas, section 2-1-5 of the Erie Municipal Code requires that all purchases for the Town be made in compliance with the Town's Purchasing Policy;

Whereas, the Town has adopted a Purchasing Policy to serve as a guideline for all purchasing activity and to establish standardized procurement procedures;

Whereas, the Town adopted an amended the Purchasing Policy in April 2025, and wishes to amend and update the Purchasing Policy further; and

Whereas, the Town Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that this Ordinance is promulgated under the Town's general police power and that this Ordinance will promote the public health, welfare, and safety of the Town.

Now, Therefore, be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Erie, Colorado:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby adopts the amended Purchasing Policy in substantially the form attached hereto.

Section 2. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one, or part, or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3. Safety. The Town Council finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect 10 days after publication following adoption.
